I. PERMISSION TO PARTICIPATE IN JROTC

I give my permission for my child to participate in the JROTC course of instruction. I understand JROTC includes classroom instruction with related study assignments, homework, written exams and performance tests, drill and ceremony training and testing, marksmanship/safety training with air rifles, and physical fitness training to include the administration of the President's Physical Fitness Test and the Army Physical Fitness Test. I also understand my child must wear his/her issued cadet uniform, which is a graded event, on prescribed days. I further understand if my child fails to wear the issued uniform as prescribed, he/she cannot successfully complete the class.

II. RESPONSIBILITY FOR ISSUED CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

I hereby accept responsibility and financial liability for all U.S. Government clothing and equipment issued to my child. I understand I am fully liable for reimbursement to the U.S. Government for all lost and missing items of uniforms and/or equipment, or for damage to uniforms and/or equipment caused by negligence or improper cleaning or care. I further understand all items of uniform and equipment are the property of the U.S. Government and are on temporary loan to my child, and all said uniforms and equipment must be returned upon demand of the Senior Army Instructor, withdrawal from the program, or at the end of the school term.

III. PRIVACY ACT OF 1974

Being aware of the provisions of the 5th USC, Section 522a (Privacy Act of 1974) and in connection with the participation of my child in the JROTC program, I hereby authorize the release of any and all records maintained by the Port St. Lucie High School JROTC program, which may contain personal information related to my child to any agency within the Department of Defense having an information requirement. My consent is effective for the period of time my child is associated with the JROTC program.

IV. HEALTH

I understand participation in JROTC requires strenuous exertion. My child will be outside in the heat of the day participating in marching, drill activities, physical fitness training and running. My child is in good health and is physically capable of participating in all phases of JROTC except for the condition(s) and limitation(s) I have listed here:

V. JROTC CADET HANDBOOK

My child received a Port St. Lucie High School JROTC Cadet Handbook; I certify I have read and am familiar with the contents and requirements of the Cadet Handbook and will abide by the conditions set forth in the Handbook. I will also require my child to abide by the requirements if he/she is a member of the Port St. Lucie High School Jaguar Battalion.

VI. MARKSMANSHIP TRAINING

The JROTC Program at Port St. Lucie High School conducts Marksmanship Training with Sporter Class Air Rifles. This training will include over 10 hours of classroom instruction in the safe use of firearms and the proper and safe use of Air Rifles. After instruction, the cadet may fire on the range at Port St. Lucie High School. The cadet will have the opportunity to qualify and earn a marksmanship badge.
