MEMORANDUM FOR: ALL JROTC CADETS, JAGUAR BATTALION

SUBJECT: Class Participation

- 1. Army JROTC is an elective course at Port St. Lucie High School. The choice to participate is yours, and yours alone.
- 2. JROTC is a course designed and based on student participation and personal development. Therefore, it is assumed that students elect to enroll in JROTC for the purpose of improving their leadership skills, self-discipline, self-confidence, and other personal traits.
- a. <u>All</u> cadets participate <u>fully</u> in Leadership Lab, Inspections, Drill & Ceremonies and Physical Training activities and classroom instruction. Nonparticipation results in a reduction of points for that day.
- b. All school rules apply in the classroom, drill area and other training areas used by JROTC. Cadets always stay in Dress Code and will not use electronic devices to include cell phones (unless authorized).
- c. Failure to dress appropriately for class participation results in a grade of zero for the day.
- 3. All cadets participate in physical activities unless there is an underlying medical condition. Cadets' must provide a doctor written note excusing them from physical activities or outlying the limits of their physical activities. The instructors may also provide the written note for obvious injury or temporary condition (on crutches, wearing of a cast). Without a written excuse, failure to participate results in a grade of zero for the day.
